## Opioid Epidemic: Update 2018 with Oral Health Practice Considerations by Harris Silver, MD

This presentation describes the properties and effects of all classes of opioids, the origin and current status of the opioid epidemic, the intersection of prescription opioids and oral health practice, and how best to prevent, treat and reduce the harms of opioid use disorder.

After retiring as an ENT/head & neck surgeon in 2005, **Dr. Silver** worked for 7 years as a drug policy analyst and advocate at local, state and national levels to foster awareness and reduce the negative consequences of the opioid, overdose and substance use disorder crises. He directs the Governor's Advisory Council on Addiction and Pain Management effort to reduce opioid use by increasing access to integrative pain treatment. Dr. Silver serves on several other related boards.

#### An Endodontic Perspective by Marc Pacheco, DDS

Evaluating the Endo/Perio Complex, the use of CBCT in diagnosing cracked teeth, Pain Management, Use of Antibiotics.

**Dr. Marc A. Pacheco** is a native New Mexican and was raised in Albuquerque. He attended The University of New Mexico where he received his Bachelors of Science in Pharmacy. He attended the University of Colorado School of Dentistry where he received his DDS degree with honors. He then practiced general dentistry in the Albuquerque area for seven years prior to pursuing his endodontic specialty training from the University of Texas in San Antonio. He is board certified with the American Board of Endodontists.


#### Au Naturale: Oral Health and Homeopathic Trends by Lancette VanGuilder, RDH, BS
